Core Duties:

- The SMT Technician will set up/operate both automated Speedline and manual DEK screen printers.
- Program, setup, and run Europlacer automated pick and place SMT machines.
- Operate Reflow ovens
- X-ray inspection using a Glenbrook X-ray machine

Other Requirements/Responsibilities:

- Operators will ensure all quality aspects for all assembly projects are being met. They may also be trained on operating other machinery related to PCB assembly. Must be flexible and help out in other areas of the manufacturing facility as needed.
- Visually inspect SMT components and process using a microscope when needed to verify that production meets our quality standards. Work closely with our quality team to ensure IPC standards are met and exceeded.
- Perform basic equipment maintenance.

Minimum 3 years SMT experience required. This is a full time "A" shift position. United States citizenship, or permanent residency is required. Overtime will be necessary depending on current workload. Current/former IPC-A-610, IPC J-STD-001, and/or IPC-7711/7721 certifications are a plus.
